Week 2: Tips for Visual/Kinesthetic Learners - Chords built from a scale

You will learn: A Process to teach visual or visual/kinesthetic learners

1. Draw a Piano
2. ID the Key Signature and make a decision as to whether the key is major or minor
3. Write the white note letters of the scale
4. Add the key signature
5. Add the scale degrees
6. Build the chords
7. add the chord qualities (this is something you will need to learn)
8. For a major scale - numbers 1 4 and 5 are major, 2, 3, and 6 are minor and the 7th is diminished.
9. This little set of notes will then help you to label the notes in the chords of the score you are trying to identify.

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
